This crowd-pleasing film features Miri, a twice-widowed, 37-year-old El Al flight attendant whose well-regulated existence is suddenly turned upside down when her Chinese housekeeper unexpectedly leaves her 6-year-old son, Noodle, in Miri's care...and doesn't return.

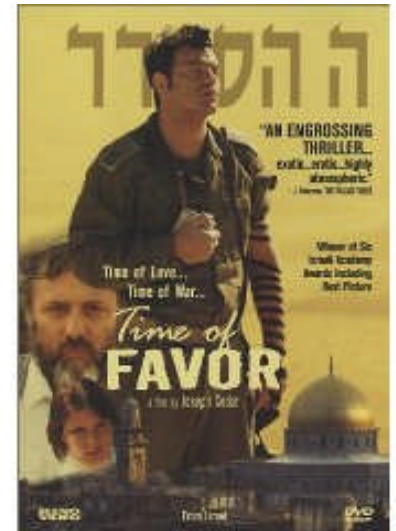
Noodle will take you on a remarkable journey of two human beings who are as different from one another as Tel Aviv is from Beijing.

The second film*, **Time of Favor**, tells a story of romance and intrigue on an Israeli settlement in the West Bank at a time when the country's political climate is explosively unsettling.

When a militant conservative rabbi hand picks a brilliant young scholar to be his daughter's husband, she rebels and throws herself at the scholar's best friend who is a popular young army commander. This tense political thriller and moving romantic drama takes place against the backdrop of the beautiful Judean hills.
