<sup>16</sup> Take care not to be lured away to serve other gods and bow to them. <sup>17</sup> For the Eternal's anger will flare up against you, shutting up the skies so that there will be no rain and the ground will not yield its produce; and you will soon perish from the good land that the Eternal is assigning to you. <sup>18</sup> Therefore impress these My words upon your very heart: bind them as a sign on your hand and let them serve as a symbol on your forehead, <sup>19</sup> and teach them to your children—reciting them when you stay at home and when you are away, when you lie down and when you get up; <sup>20</sup> and inscribe them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates— <sup>21</sup> to the end that you and your children may endure, in the land that the Eternal swore to your fathers to assign to them, as long as there is a heaven over the earth. <sup>22</sup> If, then, you faithfully keep all this Instruction that I command you, loving the Eternal your God, walking in all God's ways, and holding fast to [God], <sup>23</sup> the Eternal will dislodge before you all these nations: you will dispossess nations greater and more numerous than you. <sup>24</sup> Every spot on which your foot treads shall be yours: your territory shall extend from the wilderness to the Lebanon and from the River—the Euphrates—to the Western Sea. <sup>25</sup> No one shall stand up to you: the Eternal your God will put the dread and fear of you over the whole land in which you set foot, as promised.

<sup>14</sup> Zion says, “The Eternal has forsaken me; my Sovereign has forgotten me.” <sup>15</sup> Can a mother forget her babe, or stop loving the child of her womb? Even these could forget, but I could not forget you! <sup>16</sup> Indeed, I have inscribed you on the palms of My hands; your safety is continually in My thoughts. <sup>17</sup> Your builders drive out your destroyers, and those who wrought havoc with you depart from you. <sup>18</sup> Look up and see: they are gathering and coming to you, all of them! As I live—says the Eternal One—you shall put all of them on like ornaments, you shall bind them on yourself like a bride. <sup>19</sup> Your ruins, your abandoned places, your desolated land, shall soon be crowded with people, while those who sought to devour you shall be far off.
